



# Shawano Area Community Foundation Northbranch Methodist Scholarship

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from the following high schools:
  - o Bonduel High School
  - o Shawano Community High School
- An active member of a Methodist Church in the Shawano area
- Planning to attend an accredited four-year college or university **OR** a Wisconsin technical college as a full-time student
- Candidates should be motivated and have attained at least a "B" average (3.00 on a 4.00 system or equivalent) the last two semesters with a solid trend upward the last two years if grades have not always been at that level
- Preference will be given to students from:
  - Salem Red River United Methodist Church
  - Zion Bonduel United Methodist Church
  - Shawano United Methodist Church

### Award Amount:

One \$500 non-renewable scholarship award for tuition expenses.

## Selection:

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Selections will be recommended by the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region Scholarship Selection Committee.

## **Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:**

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

## Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of college.
