Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors and continuing college students who will be attending the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) per semester
- Planning on majoring in music, with a preference to students majoring in piano
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

One \$750 non-renewable scholarship award, payable after successful completion of fall semester.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a student majoring in music at University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh with minimum 12 credits per semester and have maintained a 3.0 GPA for fall semester.
