

The Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation Scholarship For Students Attending UWO-Fox Cities Campus

Background:

The Salmons moved to Appleton in 1972 to work in the medical field and raise their two children. In the late 1990s, Doug and Carla began to explore ways to give back to the community that had been so good to them. They concluded that the most meaningful work they could do would be of offer a helping hand to worthy students.

In 1999, they began to provide scholarship assistance to highly motivated college students who need financial assistance. By 2002, the Salmons were working with foundations at UW-Fox Valley, Fox Valley Technical College and UW-Oshkosh to provide scholarships. Lakeland University students have also benefitted.



In 2002, Doug and Carla formed the Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation, a supporting organization within the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region. Through

this partnership, they are able to fulfill their passion for sharing with others for generations to come. Doug passed away in November 2017, and The Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation Scholarships are his living legacy that will continue to help students in the future.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Undergraduate students who will be attending the UWO-Fox Cities campus
- Highly motivated
- Preference may be given to students demonstrating the following:
 - o majoring in nursing, education, business (especially accounting), or medical technology
 - o single parents, first generation college students, or older students
 - o overcoming significant financial, social, emotional or physical barriers to success
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

Number of awards and award amount may vary. Typically, between \$500 and \$1,500 per semester for tuition expenses. Based upon student performance, financial need, and availability of funding, this scholarship may be renewable.

Selection:

Selection will be recommended by the Doug & Carla Salmon Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee along with the Community Foundation. Interviews will be held for finalists.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a student for classes at UWO-Fox Cities campus.
