Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from the following high schools:
 - Appleton North High School
 - Appleton West High School
 - Kaukauna High School
- Planning to pursue a career in education
- Planning to attend a college within the University of Wisconsin School System as a full-time student
- A minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Focused goals on a career path in education
- Participation in school, community, and volunteer activities, work history

Award Amount:

One \$2,500 scholarship award for tuition expenses, payable for the first semester of the first year of college.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to maintain full-time student status with a minimum 3.0 GPA at a school within the University of Wisconsin School System pursuing a career in education.
