Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from Chilton High School
- Planning to attend an accredited 4-year college or university as a full-time student
- Pursuing a degree in agriculture, or visual or performing arts
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Involvement in extracurricular activities

Award Amount:

One non-renewable \$500 award to be used for cost of attendance.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Chilton High School Scholarship Selection Committee and one of Nicole's former teachers, if available.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and a Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of freshman year of college pursuing a degree in agriculture, visual arts or performing arts.
