

Rhoades Sanford Foundation Scholarship Fund

Background:

The Rhoades Sanford Foundation, established in 1999, provides grants that contribute to the basic needs, historical, cultural, and educational vitality of the Fox Valley Communities.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from high schools in Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Winnebago counties
- Planning to attend an accredited 4-year college or university as a part-time or full-time student
- Extracurricular activities, community service and work history with leadership roles
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

Twelve scholarship awards for cost of attendance. Each award is \$2,500 per year for two years (total award \$5,000), payable annually for the fall semester.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> (https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents as instructed in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a part-time or full-time student in good standing each year at an accredited 4-year college or university.
