



Shawano Area Community Foundation Bonduel Community and Alumni Scholarship

Background:

The Bonduel Community and Alumni Scholarship was established in 2006 by the Bonduel Scholarship Development Committee through generous donations from community members, alumni members and past graduating classes to provide post-secondary scholarships for students graduating from Bonduel High School.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors from Bonduel High School
- Planning to pursue higher education at an accredited 2- or 4- year college, university or technical school as a full-time student
- Academic achievement
- Participation in extracurricular and community activities
- Demonstrated extremely diversified interests, strong work ethic, and excellence in humanitarian efforts toward others involving kindness, caring, compassion, dignity, and respect

Award Amount:

Five \$500 non-renewable scholarship awards for tuition expenses, payable after successful completion of the first semester.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by Bonduel High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the second semester at a college/university or technical college, after successful completion of the first semester, as a student in good academic standing.
