

Shawano Area Community Foundation Maxine H. Proper Scholarship

Background:

This scholarship was established to provide awards for students graduating from Bonduel High School. The scholarship is not intended for only the “best students”. Instead, the ideal recipient is someone who may have had a hard time excelling at everything since a freshman, due to various reasons, including but not limited to involvement in a multitude of activities, or the need to help at home. The ideal recipient may not have the highest grades, but demonstrates diversified interests, has found focus the last year or two and/or has a good trend upward. The motivation, focus, and interests of the student will be considered.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating seniors from Bonduel High School
- Planning to attend an accredited 2- or 4-year college, university or technical school as a full-time student
- Participating in a nursing or medical-related program
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA in the last two semesters with a solid trend upward in the last two years if previous grades were not at that level
- Demonstrated motivation, participation in activities, diversified interests and a sense of focus

Award Amount:

One \$5,000 renewable scholarship award for cost of attendance, payment schedule varies based on if the student is enrolled in a 2-year or 4-year program.

If student is attending a 4-year program, \$1,250 payable annually during the fall semesters for four years.

If student is attending a 2-year program, \$1,250 payable each fall and spring semester for two years.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Bonduel High School Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student’s responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student majoring in a nursing or medical-related program and remain in good academic standing.
