



Charlie & Loie Kliefoth Scholarship

Background:

This scholarship was established in 1992 by alumnus Charles Kliefoth to provide a scholarship, with a preference to a student majoring in history. The fund was renamed to include the name of his beloved wife Loie who passed away in March 2005, and whose memorial gifts were added to the fund.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors or continuing college students from the Fox Valley area and will be attending a 2-year or 4-year UW institution as a full-time student.
 - *Fox Valley is defined as the Community Foundation's service area: Calumet, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Neenah-Menasha area of Winnebago counties*
- Graduating high school seniors must have a minimum cumulative 3.25 GPA
- Continuing college students must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Preference will be given to students pursuing a major in History
- Preference will be given to students who plan to or are attending UW-Oshkosh

Award Amount:

One \$2,000 scholarship award payable at \$1,000 each in the fall and spring semesters.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation scholarship selection committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to enroll with a minimum of 12 credits in the fall semester at a 2-year or 4-year UW institution.
