

Patricia S. Warrick Scholarship

Background: This scholarship was established in 2006 by Emeritus Professor of English, Patricia S. Warrick. She was an American literary scholar, editor and author in Science Fiction and Technology while teaching at the UW-Fox Valley campus for 30 years. She retired in 1996.



Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors or continuing college students from the Fox Valley area and will be attending a 2-year or 4-year UW institution as a full-time student
- Preference for students attending UW- Milwaukee
 - *Fox Valley is defined as the Community Foundation's service area: Calumet, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Neenah-Menasha area of Winnebago counties*
- Planning to major in Education, English, and/or Science/Research, or a Technology related field.
- Community involvement with special considerations for those who volunteer and/or have work history with libraries

Award Amount:

One \$2,500 scholarship award payable at \$1,250 in the fall and spring semesters.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>).

Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) at a UW institution
