



McCormick Family Scholarship

Background:

This scholarship honors Beverly McCormick by supporting students who share her love of nature and are committed to preserving the environment for future generations.

Today we are confronted with environmental challenges that, if not solved, will have a devastating impact on future generations. Today's students, through education, have the opportunity to make a positive environmental impact on the world around them through their selected course of study. Whether this takes the form of environmental science, technology, engineering, political or legal activism, education, etc., any student has the ability to make a difference and may apply for this scholarship opportunity.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors who attend a public or parochial school including those homeschooled in one of the following counties:
 - Calumet
 - Outagamie
 - Shawano
 - Waupaca
 - Winnebago
- Planning to attend an accredited 4-year college or university as a full-time student majoring in one of the following areas:
 - Science related field
 - Environmental related field
 - STEM-related field
 - Any other field that impacts environmental challenges
- Demonstrates the following: forward-thinking contributions to the future state of the world and passionate about the importance of science
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

Two \$1,500 non-renewable scholarships, payable in the first semester of college.

Selection:

Recipients will be recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Online Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for the first semester of the freshman year of college.
