Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Continuing college students including graduate students who are from the Fox Valley Region and will be attending a technical college, 2-year or 4-year college/university as a full-time student
 - *Fox Valley is defined as the Community Foundation's service area: Calumet, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Neenah-Menasha area of Winnebago counties*
- Minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
- Preference given to graduate level studies students
- Preference given to those who have work history and/or community involvement

Award Amount:

Award numbers and amounts may vary.

Selection:

Recipients are selected each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc. After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Online Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to enroll as a full-time student and maintain good academic standing.
