



Business & Accounting Scholarship Fund

Background:

The anonymous donors who established this scholarship fund wanted to make an impact on student's lives who intend to make their impact in the world of business, accounting, economics or related fields.

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors or continuing college students from the Fox Valley area and will be attending a 2-year or 4-year UW institution with a minimum of 9 credits per semester
 - *Fox Valley is defined as the Community Foundation's service area: Calumet, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Neenah-Menasha area of Winnebago counties*
- Pursuing a degree in business, economics, or accounting
- Must have a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA
- Must have participated in a business focused extracurricular and/or school club for at least a year
- Financial need will be considered

Award Amount:

One \$2,000 award, payable at \$1,000 each for fall and spring semester for one year.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to enroll with a minimum of 9 credits per semester at a 2-year or 4-year UW institution with a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA and majoring in business, economics or accounting.
