



Howard and Alice Curler Academic Excellence Scholarship

Eligibility: (taken into consideration to determine recipients)

- Graduating high school seniors or continuing college students from the Fox Valley area and will be attending a 2-year or 4-year UW institution as full-time student
 - *Fox Valley is defined as the Community Foundation's service area: Calumet, Outagamie, Shawano, Waupaca and Neenah-Menasha area of Winnebago counties*
- High school seniors and continuing college students must have maintained a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA
- Pursuing any major
- Demonstrated community and school leadership qualities



Award Amount:

Three \$3,000 scholarship awards, payable at \$1,500 each for first and second semesters.

Selection:

Recipients are recommended each spring by the Community Foundation scholarship selection committee.

Collecting the Award & Payment Procedure:

Recipients must fill out and submit Scholarship Acceptance Form and Scholarship Verification Form through the [Scholarship Portal](https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar) (<https://www.grantinterface.com/Home/Logon?urlkey=cffvrscholar>). Recipients are required to provide supporting documents *as instructed* in the Scholarship Verification Form, such as class registration/list **with** credits listed, proof of major, grade transcript, etc.

After approval of online Scholarship Verification Form, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending. The **Community Foundation communicates with students via email**; it is the student's responsibility to keep their Scholarship Portal account updated with their current email address.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student (minimum 12 credits) attending a 2-year or 4-year UW institution in good academic standing.
